

April 11, 2022 (day 47)

Demining work is underway in the northern parts of the state liberated from the occupiers. The enemy continues to strike at Ukraine's critical infrastructure to complicate the transportation and supply of cargo, particularly to battlefields. An explosion took place at night at one of the railway stations in eastern Ukraine, this is the second railway station after **Kramatorsk**. 5 locomotives, tracks and catenary were damaged.

As a result of the shelling of **Kharkiv region** on Sunday, April 10, 10 people were killed and 11 others were injured. In Kharkiv, slow-moving mines are found among residential buildings - ammunition with a small plastic body, sappers now work there. The use of such weapons violates the principles of Geneva law, as they can harm civilians and infrastructure. As a result of the April 11 shelling in the Kharkiv region, 8 people died.

In the **Donetsk region** on April 10, two people were killed and four were injured in shelling by the Russian military. In the afternoon of April 11, the village of Mykhailivka was shelled, as a result of which 30 houses were damaged.

April 10 was also the day of the greatest destruction due to rocket fire by the Russian occupiers in the **Dnipropetrovsk region**.

At night there was an explosion near Nikolaev, it caused a forest fire. In the **Mykolaiv area** the Russian military resorted to the forbidden method of war - treachery - changed into civilian clothes and attacked positions of the Ukrainian military.

The most critical situation remains in the city of **Mariupol**, which has been under siege almost since the beginning of hostilities. Tonight, the use of an unknown substance (probably a chemical weapon) was reported, which was dropped from an enemy drone.

In the temporarily occupied districts of **Luhansk region**, the occupation authorities are mobilizing males under 65 years of age. Such actions are also prohibited by international humanitarian law.

A mass grave was found in the village of **Buzova, Kyiv region**. In Borodyanka, 7 more civilians were rescued from the rubble, with a total of 19 victims.

The Russian military captured the sailors of the cargo ship SMARTA and took them in an unknown direction. The capture of civilians is prohibited by treaty and customary law of international humanitarian law.

As of today, **183 children have died** and 342 have been injured in the Russian aggression.

Croatia has expelled 24 Russian embassy staff for invading Ukraine. **France** is sending six Russian embassy staff accused of espionage.
