

**May 11, 2022 (77 day)**

The Russians continue to deport people from Ukraine, in particular, 8,787 people have been deported in the last 24 hours, including 1,106 children. Grain and vegetables are also exported from the **Kherson region** to the Crimea, which complicates the already critical situation with food supply in the south of the country.

This morning, the Russian military launched missile strikes on Slovyansk, **Donetsk region**, and no one was injured. Air raids on the Azovstal plant in the blockade of **Mariupol** continue, and the plant is also shelled with artillery and tanks. The occupiers destroyed the second hospital on Azovstal, and Ukrainian fighters were left with no medicine, tools or bandages.

The territory of **Chernihiv region** was shelled again with mortars.

In the morning, the air defense forces shot down a missile near **Zaporizhia**, it exploded over the infrastructure object, causing significant damage.

The occupiers closed the valves of the Shebelinka-Novopskov main gas pipeline, leaving the population of **Luhansk and Donetsk regions** without Ukrainian gas supply. Due to the fighting, Luhansk region has long been without electricity, water, gas and mobile communications.

In the temporarily occupied **Kherson**, the collaborators said they would ask the Russian president to join the federation.

Today explosions were also heard in Kramatorsk, Poltava and Ivano-Frankivsk regions, a rocket shot down in the direction of Odessa was shot down.

According to the UN, 5 million Ukrainians lost their jobs due to the war.
