On April 4, the **President of Ukraine** signed a Decree on the establishment of a delegation to participate in negotiations on the preparation and approval of a draft agreement on security guarantees for Ukraine.

The Russian military has provided a list of Ukrainian **prisoners of war**, which is mandatory under international humanitarian law, but does not provide access to the International Committee of the Red Cross. The released Ukrainian servicemen report that they were treated inhumanely by the Russian side. There are currently about 600 prisoners of war in Ukraine.

Yesterday the Russian military inflicted 54 strikes on the **Kharkiv region** and the city, 6 people were killed and 8 were injured.

Today in Rubizhne, **Luhansk region**, the Russian military hit a tank with nitric acid, which is dangerous if inhaled, swallowed and in contact with skin and mucous membranes. In the city, the dead are buried in the yards of houses. Due to the intense shelling of Rubizhne and Popasna, neither rescuers nor ambulance doctors can get there.

At night, Kramatorsk, **Donetsk region**, was hit, destroying the school. Tonight seven blows were inflicted on the phenolic plant in the Donetsk region.

Stockpiles of food, medicine and fuel are beginning to run out in captured **Kherson**. All 300,000 people oppose the occupation of Russia.

There are still 130,000 people in the blocked **Mariupol**. Yesterday, 3,376 people were evacuated through humanitarian corridors. The enemy destroyed all municipal buses in the city to prevent the evacuation of people from Mariupol. The city held a new mayor with the support of the Russian military, recognized the so-called referendum in 2014 and believes that Mariupol belongs to the DPR.

Last night, **Mykolayiv** was fired upon from the Tornado's multiple rocket launchers - cluster munitions exploded near retail outlets and public transport stops, killing 10 and injuring 46 civilians. The attack was also carried out on the children's hospital. Such indiscriminate attacks on the city are a gross violation of the laws and customs of war.

The bodies of tortured and killed people were found in the basement of a children's camp in **Bucha**. Ukrainian and international investigators are documenting numerous war crimes and crimes against humanity committed by the Russian military in Irpein, Bucha, and Borodyanka. Currently, 1,200 war crimes committed by the Russian military have been recorded.

In the **Ternopil region**, a rocket attack damaged a tank with liquid ammonia fertilizers, which spilled into the soil and penetrated into aquifers.

In the town of Pologi, **Zaporizhia region**, the occupiers seized the territory of the district hospital, and wounded Russian servicemen are in the facility.

Yesterday, **Germany** sent 40 employees of the Russian embassy. **Italy** sends 30 Russian diplomats. **Denmark** is sending 15 Russian embassy staff. **Spain** is sending at least 25 Russian diplomats.

A meeting of the **United Nations Security Council** on Ukraine's war crimes in Ukraine is taking place today. Most countries have condemned the actions of the Russian military in the temporarily occupied territories.
