

March 20, 2022 (day 25)

Shelling and rocket bombings continue in Ukrainian cities. The enemy uses high-precision weapons, unguided aerial bombs and high-impact ammunition. The terror of the local population continues.

228 people have died in **Kyiv** since the beginning of the invasion.

Fighting continues in the city of **Kharkiv**. Fires broke out as a result of the shelling of Northern Saltivka and Velyka Danylivka. Five civilians were killed in the night shelling of the city.

The city of **Chernihiv** is shelled daily, the Remzavod housing estate has been damaged. On March 19, the western part of the city was shelled, which led to an outbreak of 3 fires at infrastructure facilities (fuel and lubricants warehouse, plastic products factory). Ten residential buildings were also occupied. The city was left without electricity, heat and water.

As a result of a missile strike on March 18 the military barracks in **Mykolaiv** was destroyed. The bodies of at least 50 people were recovered from the rubble. The Russian military continues to shell residential neighbourhoods with rocket artillery and rockets.

In the evening of March 19, the village of Pivovar near Ovruch in the **Zhytomyr** region was shelled, and the village was completely destroyed.

The Russian military does not allow a humanitarian convoy (14 trucks with food and essential medicines) to **Kherson** region. The occupiers are robbing the villages.

The village of Velyka Kostromka near the **Kryvyi Rih** CHP was shelled.

Mobilization was illegally announced in the temporarily occupied territory of **Donetsk region**.

In the city of **Energodar** reported the abduction of First Deputy Mayor Ivan Samoidyuk.

In the town of Kreminna, **Luhansk region**, on March 20, 2022, a house for the elderly was fired upon from a tank (56 people died, 15 people were abducted). Three people were killed during the shelling in Rubizhne and Severodonetsk over the past 24 hours. Gas supply to Uglehirskaya TPP resumed after shelling by occupiers. Electricity supply has been restored for 100,000 people, but more than 273,000 people remain without gas supply, and more than 1,327 settlements (872,000 people) remain without electricity.

The situation in the city of **Mariupol** remains one of the most difficult. Over the past week, several thousand people have been forcibly evacuated from Mariupol to Russia. On March 19, the Russian occupiers dropped bombs on the №12 art school, where about 400 people were hiding. The school building is completely destroyed. On March 20, the city of Mariupol was shelled by 4 warships.
