

May 10, 2022 (76 day)

In the **Kyiv region**, demining of previously occupied areas continues, 583 explosive devices were neutralized the previous day.

One person was killed and five were injured in the evening rocket attacks (seven rockets) in **Odessa** on May 9. The Riviera shopping center, a warehouse, was hit, and cars parked nearby were damaged. Today, for the fourth time, a missile strike was launched on the bridge across the Dniester estuary.

In the city of Izyum, **Kharkiv region**, temporarily occupied, the bodies of 44 civilians were found under the rubble of a house destroyed in March. On the way out of Kharkiv, the bodies of three civilians were found in Tsyrkuny.

In besieged **Mariupol**, Russian troops continue to fire on the Azovstal plant, there are wounded who need to be evacuated immediately and provided with adequate medical care and food. The wounded are in unsanitary conditions, bandaged with the remains of non-sterile bandages, without proper medication and food. The Azovstal plant is shelled from naval and barrel artillery, tanks, and aircraft.

The shelling of **Sumy region** has been going on for the last two days.

The city of Severodonetsk in the **Luhansk region** was left without gas supply through a broken main gas pipeline. The region has been shelled 22 times in the last 24 hours, and residential buildings in Severodonetsk and Lysychansk have been destroyed.

In the **Dnipropetrovsk region**, Zelenodolsk artillery was fired upon in the morning, and residential buildings were damaged.

The Russian occupiers continue to **export grain** from Ukraine. In Polohy, Zaporizhia region, sunflower seeds and seeds are being prepared for transportation to Russia. The harvest stored in Energodar is also confiscated. Grain trucks also export grain from hangars in the **Kharkiv region**. 1,500 tons were exported from the Kherson region to the occupied Crimea.
