

March 23, 2022 (day 28)

Airstrikes on **Chernihiv** continue. More than 150,000 people left the city. About 40 people die every day in the city. Exits from the city are mined. The city remains under siege. Today, air bombs were dropped on the bridge over the Desna River, and humanitarian aid was delivered to the city.

In **Kyiv**, shelling damaged a shopping center, private homes and high-rise apartment buildings (four people were injured). The occupiers fired on the Brovary district of **Kyiv region**, as a result of which vegetable and meat warehouses and dozens of tons of food were destroyed. Bucha district of **Kyiv region** on the verge of a humanitarian catastrophe. Information on Russia's use of banned phosphorus munitions in Irpen and Gostomel is being checked.

The Russian military launched missile strikes on peaceful neighborhoods in the town of Lozova in the **Kharkiv** region (8 people were injured, 20 houses were damaged or destroyed). Fighting continues for the city of Izyum.

In the evening of March 22, one of the houses in Rubizhne, **Luhansk** region, was hit (three children died).

The shelling continued in Avdiivka, **Donetsk** region. Part of the city without electricity. They were excited - occupied. The Ocheretyne railway station was shelled.

As a result of night attacks of the city of Mykolaiv two people were lost.

Mariupol is under blockade, air strikes on the city, strikes with the use of artillery and warships continue. The enemy uses forbidden tactics of scorched earth. The Russian military destroyed the building of the Arkhip Kuindzhi Art Museum.

On March 22, a railway station in Pavlohrad, **Dnipropetrovsk Oblast**, was destroyed.
